Our strengths

- 1. Fast case handling
- 2. High level of digitalization of the judiciary
- 3. Growing capacity to apply foreign law



The average timeframe for consideration of cases in 2023:

First instance – 79 days

Second instance – 67 days

Third instance – 45 days

TOTAL – 191 days (about 6-7 months)



In 2023, commercial courts of first instance issued 127 974 decisions:

- -23 099 appeals (18%)
- 9 183 appeals to the cassation court (7%)

The Supreme Court overturned decisions in 16% of cases and sent them back for a new trial.

Application of foreign law:

Companies Act 2006 was mentioned in 83 judgements



Our weaknesses

- 1. Corruption
- 2. Lack of uniformity of court practice
- 3. Bad quality of court decisions





Reasons for the poor quality of judgments:

- Huge caseload (decisions drafted mainly by legal assistants, not by judges);
- The false presumption that the outcome of the case is important, not motivation (focus on outcomes versus the quality of decision motivation);
- Deciding on the outcome of the case immediately after oral augments of the parties;
- Judges are not capable of writing well (bad legal education system).
